Dexamethasone Sodium Phosphate Possible Adverse Reaction Potential Contraindications / Warnings and Precautions Ocular discomfort, Increased IOP, Conjunctival hemorrhage, Infants and patients less than 12 years of age, Lactation, Conjunctival hyperemia, Anterior chamber inflammation, Pregnancy. Known hyperensitivy to any of components. Burning and stinging sensation, Eye irritation and infection, Epithelial herpes simplex keratitis, Acute infectious stages of Eye pain, Post-injection flare, Wound healing suppression, vaccinia, varicella and many other viral diseases of the corneal Corneal perforation, Headache, Vitreous detachment, and conjuctiva. Mycobacterial infection of the eye, fungal Subcapsular cataract, Ocular hypertension, Optic nerve diseases of the eye. Monitor IOP. Prolonged use may result damage, Visual field defect. Bacterial keratitis with the use of in ocular hypertension and/or glaucoma and increase risk of multiple dose containers. secondary ocular infections. **Moxifloxacin HCI** Possible Adverse Reaction **Potential Contraindications / Warnings and Precautions** Conjunctivitis, Decreased visual acuity, Dry eye, Keratitis, Ocular Patients less than 1 year, Lactation, Pregnancy.
