- 1 OSRX Will Contact You**
OSRX Pharmacy will send you an **email and/or text** with your order number and payment link to verify your address and pay online. We'll also give you a **quick call from (406) 541-6121** to help you finish the process if needed.
- 2 Make Your Payment & Confirm Your Address**
If payment and address confirmation haven't already been completed over the phone, simply visit verifymyosrx.com and enter your order number to complete the process.
- 3 Your Prescription Will Ship**
Once your payment is received, OSRX will ship your prescription and send you a text with your tracking number.
- 4 Check Your Mail**
Your prescription will arrive via USPS Ground Advantage (3-7 business days).
